Privacy Policy

Wisley with Pyrford is strongly committed to protecting your privacy while interacting with our content and services.

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to tell you what kind of information we may gather about you when you visit our site, how we may use that information, whether we disclose it to anyone, and the choices you have regarding our use of, and your ability to correct this information. Our policy allows you to choose what kind and how much information you provide to us and to control how we use whatever information you give us. Our goal is to provide you with a satisfying experience while allowing you to control your privacy and to give you a means to voice any questions or concerns you may have.

This policy applies only to Wisley with Pyrford and not to other companies' or organisations' websites to which Wisley wth Pyrford is linked.

Collection of Information

Information is collected from you primarily to make it easier and more rewarding for you to use our services. Depending on the service you are accessing, you could be asked to provide information such as your name, e-mail address and other contact details. It is entirely your choice whether to respond to these questions or not, but may mean you do not receive the full benefit of that service.

Wisley with Pyrford collects two types of information. The first type is anonymous information. For instance, we may collect information to tell us that five thousand people visit this Privacy Policy today, but we do not know their names, where they live or their date of birth - they are 'anonymous' to us. Most of the individuals who access our site are anonymous to us.

The second type of information that Wisley with Pyrford collects is personal information. Wisley with Pyrford will collect personal information that lets us know the specifics of who you are such as your name, e-mail address, or postal address, when you provide it to us. With this information, Wisley with Pyrford can provide a variety of personalised and enhanced services that are not available to anonymous users. We hope that you will find it beneficial to provide individually identifiable information about yourself to us because it will make us more able to respond to your needs.

This information may also be used to inform you of additional products and services which may interest you. You can choose not to receive such information when you are undertaking product or service registration on our website.

Use of Anonymous Information

Wisley with Pyrford automatically gathers anonymous information to monitor the use of Wisley with Pyrford web site. We only use such data in the aggregate. This collective data helps us determine how much parts of the site are visited, to help guide us in improving the website to assure that it is kept as up to date as possible. Wisley with Pyrford do not publish or provide this aggregate data to other people.

Use of Personal Information

Wisley with Pyrford will only use the personal information you have chosen to provide us for the purpose for which you provided it. Wisley with Pyrford will not use it for any other purpose without your consent. Only if you select our mailshot option when subscribing to one of our services will we send out mailers that we may think you will find of interest. We may contact you to see if you found what you were looking for.

Cookies

The Wisley with Pyrford site uses cookies to help us better understand the use of our web site, only anonymous information is gathered. The various interactive areas of our site, any data entered is stored in session variables, which only hold your information whilst the web browser is open, closing the web browser clears all of this information. Further information about the use of Cookies is detailed in the Cookies & Privacy section below.

Disclosure

There will be occasions where it will be necessary for Wisley with Pyrford to disclose your personal information to third parties. Wisley with Pyrford may be required by law to disclose the information, or Wisley with Pyrford may be required to disclose your personal information to third parties to provide the service you have requested, for example, if you requested a quotation, Wisley with Pyrford may disclose your personal information to a third party who may be better situated to service your needs. However, the disclosure will only be made where it is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which you disclosed your personal information. Otherwise than stated above, we do not disclose personal information that you may give us, such as your name, address, e-mail address or telephone number, to any organisation or person outside the Parish of Wisley with Pyrford unless you have authorised us to do so.

No sale of Personal Information

Under no circumstances will Wisley with Pyrford sell or receive payment for licensing or disclosing your personal information.

Access and Correction: Personal Data

If Wisley with Pyrford holds your personal information. Wisley with Pyrford will where possible provide you with access to the information. You may request this information from Wisley with Pyrford via e-mail or telephon. Wisley with Pyrford will take reasonable steps to correct the information so that it is accurate, complete and up to date.
