Vacancy update

For an overview of the Vacancy process and timeline for appointing Nick's successor, please see the Archdeacon's Newsletter dated January 2024.

Following the open meeting with the Archdeacon of Dorking on 29 January and a successful Parochial Church Council (PCC) workshop led by a senior member of the Diocesan staff on 22 February, a team agreed by the PCC is now in the process of putting together a parish profile and person specification laying out our priorities and the gifts we are seeking in a new leader.

The profile will be compiled following wide consultation and will include input from the workshop and the Ministry Team's Away Day on 16 February.

A draft profile will be presented to the PCC for approval at its meeting in early April before then being submitted to the Diocese.

Further updates will follow when significant steps in the process are reached, but if you have any questions about what will happen during the Vacancy or the procedure for appointing Nick's replacement, please feel free to ask any of the churchwardens or members of the PCC.

In the meantime, please help by praying that God will call the right person to be our new incumbent and for wisdom in discerning this. Please also remember in your prayers the churchwardens, PCC, vacancy teams and all those who have additional responsibility during this time.
